Key Responsibilities

- Installing new and replacement IT related resources including new PCs, notebooks and software;
- LAN users support, troubleshooting and systems corrections;
- Assisting in the administration of the enterprise systems including email and other services;
- Assisting in the installation and technical support of center servers and databases;
- Actively contributing in the development and maintenance of the disaster recovery procedure for IT supported systems;
- Assisting in the development of IT policies for Regional Offices;
- Assisting in the development of standard helpdesk procedures and service level agreements and responsible for meeting the service level agreements for helpdesk support;
- Providing technical support to the remote access systems and remote users;
- Monitoring the operation of the leased line, router, and firewall;
- Attending to helpdesk requests and providing IT assistance to users i.e. troubleshoot reported systems problem, solve or escalate the problem accordingly (liaison person for vendors for hardware and software);
- Providing consultation and assisting in science related systems and processes implementation;
- Carrying out IT related routine operations such as systems backup and users' profiles maintenance; and
- Providing assistance in keeping inventory of hardware, peripherals and software - assisting in the mobilization of these resources to staff.

Skills and abilities

- Possess strong technical skills in desktop and notebook troubleshooting;
- Possess good knowledge of the Microsoft OS and Office suite;
- Client-oriented attitude; and
- Good communication skills especially in English language.

Qualifications and experience

- Degree or Diploma in IT or related field;
- 2 years working experience in administrating medium to large scale IT backend infrastructure;
- Fresh graduates with excellent academic record may be considered on a case to case basis;
- Exposure to LAN / WAN and wireless technologies; and
- Working experience on disaster recovery procedures would be an added advantage.
