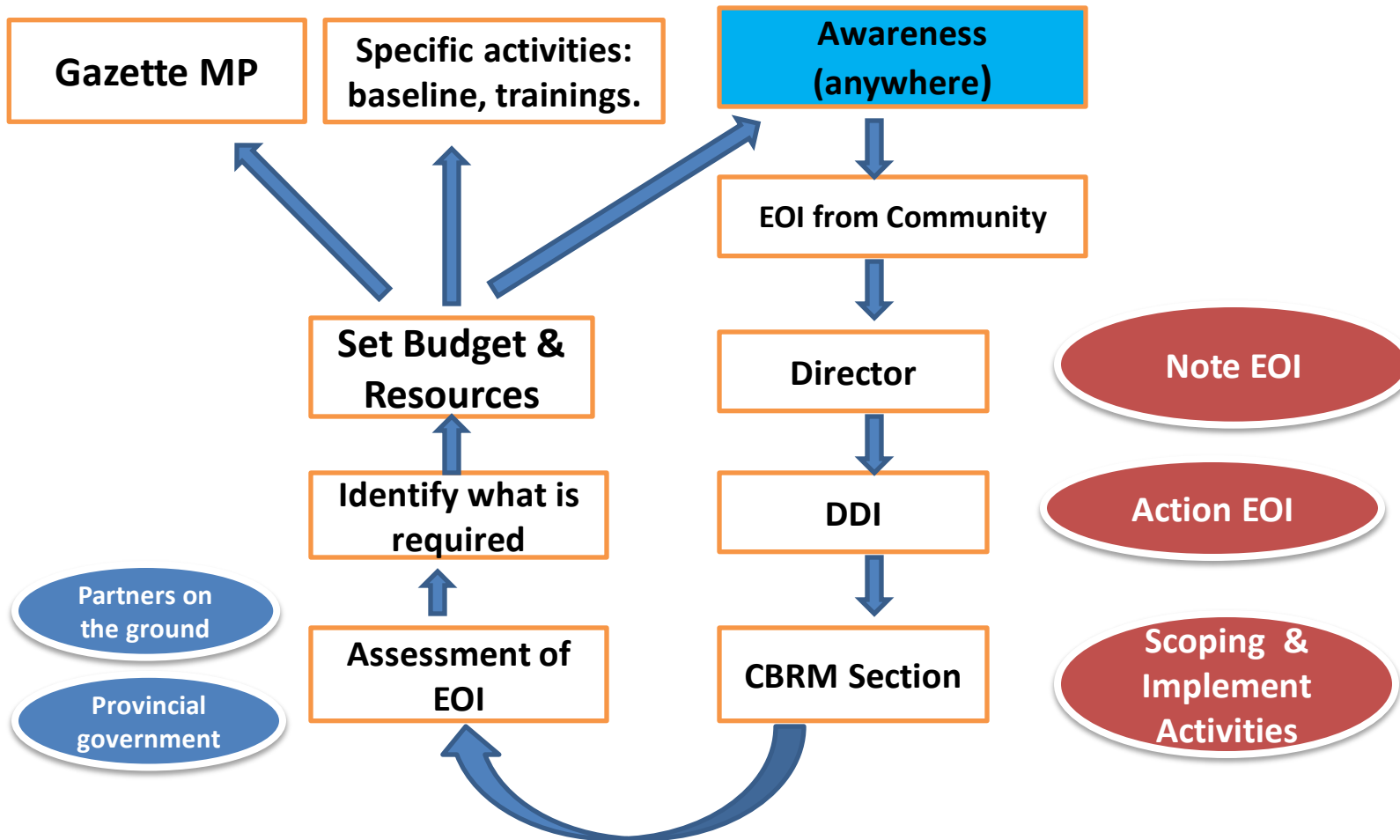

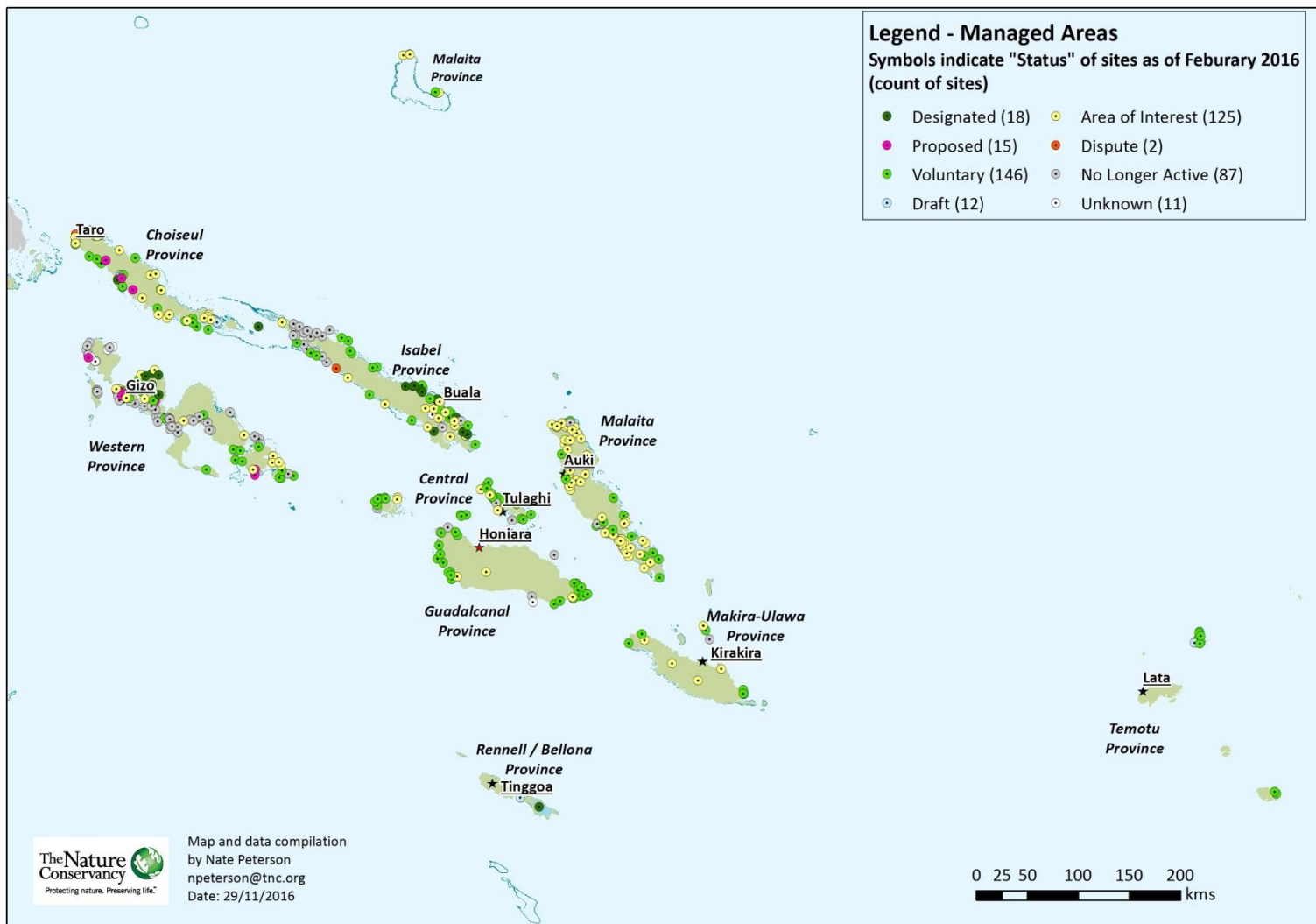
1. IMPORTANCE OF AWARENESS

- A lot of communities to visit at one time



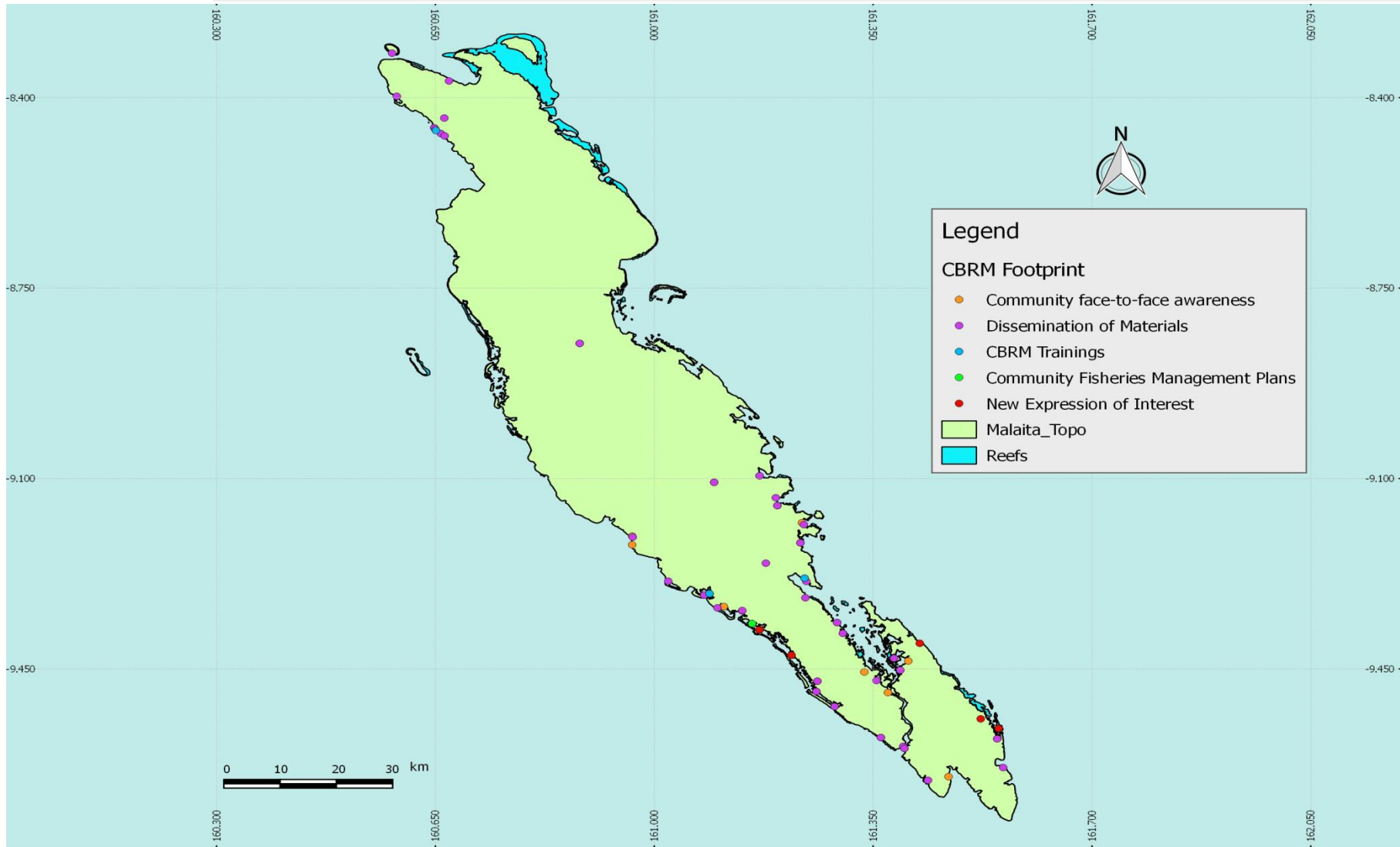
3. MFMR AWARENESS APPROACHES

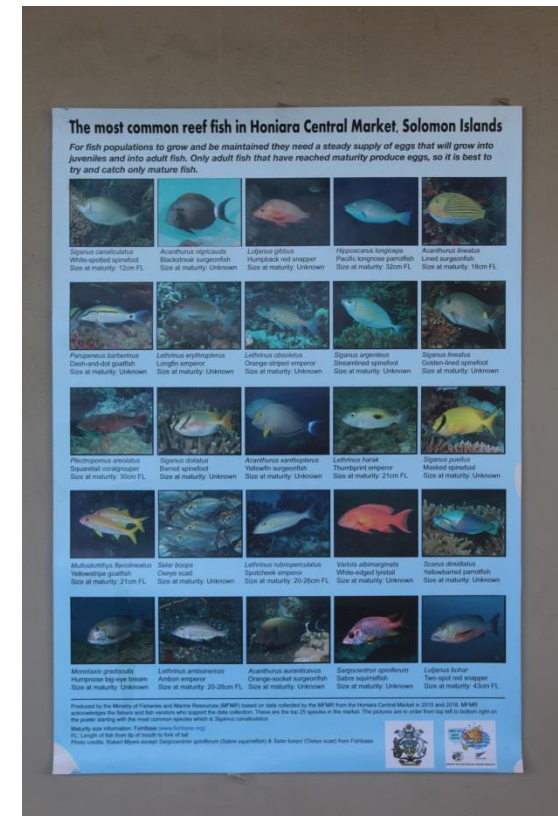

MFMR SUPPORT FOR AWARENESS

- Policy support

- Establishment of Information Unit
- Collaboration with PFOs (mandatory)
- Inshore CBRM Workplan – specific component on awareness
- Budget support – travel, printing etc
