

HISTORY OF KAHUA ASSOCIATION

- The original idea within the Kahua Association was to pool together the 40 communities of Provincial Wards 12 &13 to work together to address longstanding common problems of the area
- Kahua Association was registered on the 26th day of October 2005.
- In 2010 the Association did not function well due to the absence of the General Secretary who left to work in a paid job.
- On 10th November 2015 during a consultation meeting of SICCP on the project "In search of the Makira moorhen," a new Executive was elected. SICCP may have not found the Makira Moorhen, but finding and reviving the Kahua Association could be seen as a result of this SICCP CEPF Project.


PROJECT
